

17. Cartage Charges between Wairoa and Morere, Wharerata, Kopua, Bartletts', Muriwai, Manutuke, Matawhero, Gisborne, and Points beyond Gisborne.

Parcels and goods traffic (Classes C, D, E, and E plus 50 per cent.), except fish and oysters, will be accepted for conveyance from any station by rail to Wairoa, thence by road to the points specified hereunder, or *vice versa*, at the appropriate rail rates to and from Wairoa plus cartage charges between Wairoa and destination, as scheduled hereunder:—
