payments extending over a period not exceeding five years: Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by the said Act, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby order and direct the sale of the land described in the Schedule hereto, and doth hereby authorize, pursuant to the said section thirty-six, the acceptance of the purchase-price in instalments extending over a period not exceeding five years.
