IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on him by subsection one of section six of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, being of opinion that there is a doubt or uncertainty as to whether the land described in the Schedule hereto was immediately before the commencement of the said Act a public reserve within the meaning of section two of the Public Reserves and Domains Act, 1908, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby declare that the said land is a public reserve for a site for a Town Hall and Municipal Buildings within the meaning of the Act first above mentioned.
