## WALLACE COUNTY COUNCIL.

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

**I**N pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Wallace County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £10,000, authorized to be raised by the Wallace County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of making advances to farmers for the erection

of dwellings under the Rural Housing Act, 1939, such loan to be called the ‘Rural Housing Loan,’ the said Wallace County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-twentieth of a penny ( $\frac{1}{20}$ d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property of the whole of the County of Wallace; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each year and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
