A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Land Act, 1924, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby amend the Proclamation dated the tenth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 12 of the thirteenth day of the same month, at page 244, proclaiming land as road, and road closed, in Block VIII, Shotover Survey District, Lake County, by revoking the First Schedule to the said Proclamation and substituting in lieu thereof the Schedule hereto.
