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ELLESMERE LANDS DRAINAGE BOARD.

HALSWELL DREDGING LOAN, 1940.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Ellesmere Lands Drainage Board hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest, instalments of principal, and other charges on a loan of six thousand pounds, authorized to be raised by the Ellesmere Lands Drainage Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of purchasing a drag-line dredge and pontoon for dredging the Halswell River and drains in the Board's district and the cost of carrying out such work, the said Ellesmere Lands Drainage Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of thirteen sixty-fourths ($\frac{13}{64}$ d.) of a penny in the pound on the rateable value on the basis of the capital value of all land classified as Class A, and nine sixty-fourths ($\frac{9}{64}$ d.) of a penny in the pound on the rateable value on the basis of the capital value of all land classified as Class B, and three thirty-seconds ($\frac{3}{32}$ d.) of a penny in the pound on the rateable value on the basis of the capital value of all land classified as Class C in the River Area of the Board's district; and that such special rates shall be annual-recurring rates during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen years or until the loan is fully paid up.”
