IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Bulls Town Board on the twelfth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and forty, in so far as it affects the side and portion of the street described in the Schedule hereto, viz:—

“That the Bulls Town Board, being the local authority having control of the streets in the Bulls Town District, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to that portion of street, known as Gorton Street, adjoining Section 17, Block C, Town of Bulls, part Block III, Rangitikei District”;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the northern side of the portion of Gorton Street (described in the Schedule hereto), within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.

“That the Takaka County Council, being the local authority having control of the roads in the Takaka County, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the north-western side of portion of Swamp Road, passing through part Section 66, Takaka District, Block V, Waitapu Survey District”;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the north-western side of the portion of Swamp Road (described in the Schedule hereto), within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of road.
