A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section three of the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Amendment Act, 1919, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Proclamation made on the twenty-ninth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, and published in the *Gazette* of the fourth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, setting apart land for disposal by way of sale or

lease to discharged soldiers under special tenures in the manner provided by the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915.
