RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Selwyn County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other "That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £10,000, authorized to be raised by the Selwyn County Council under the above-mentioned Act for advances to farmers under the Rural Housing Act, 1939, the said Selwyn County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-tenth of a penny (½0 in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the special rating area, comprising the whole of the County of Selwyn; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 14th day of August in each year and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years or until the loan is fully paid off.'
