A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the Scenery Preservation Board, constituted pursuant to the Scenery Preservation Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), has recommended that the land described in the Schedule hereto should be permanently reserved for scenic purposes, and it is expedient to give effect to such recommendation:

Now, therefore, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the said Act, do hereby proclaim and declare that the lands described in the Schedule hereto shall be a scenic reserve under the said Act, and subject to the provisions thereof.

SCHEDULE.

MARLBOROUGH LAND DISTRICT.

ALL that area containing by admeasurement 2 acres, 1 rood 10 perches, being portion of 3B of 2, Mangamaunu Native Block, situated in Block XV, Puhipuhi Survey District, and being the land shown as Lot C on plan 1546/76, deposited in the office of the Chief Surveyor at Blenheim.

Also all that area containing by admeasurement 2 acres 3 roads 8.2 perches, being portion of 3A of 2 of the said Native block and being the land shown as Lot D on the said plan 1546/76.

Also all that area containing by admeasurement 2.4 perches, being portion of 3C of 2 of the said Native block, and being the land shown as Lot E on plan 1546/76.

Also all that area containing by admeasurement 14.9 perches, being portion of 3C of 2 of the said Native block, and being the land shown as Lot F on plan 1546/76.
