Amending an Order in Council authorizing the Uawa County Council to erect Electric Lines in Portion of the Uawa

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on him by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power enabling him in that behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby revoke the Order in Council dated the twenty-seventh day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, and published in the New Zealand Gazette No. 30 of the third day of May, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, and doth hereby amend the Zealand Gazette No. 30 of the third day of May, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, and doth hereby amend the Order in Council dated the fourteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, and published in the New Zealand Gazette No. 48 of the seventeenth day of the same month, authorizing the Uawa County Council to erect electric lines in portion of the Uawa County, by revoking clause three thereof (charges for electrical energy) and substituting therefor the following clause, viz.:—

"3. CHARGES FOR ELECTRICAL ENERGY.
