IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby amend the Order in Council dated the fifteenth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 77 of the eighteenth day of the same month, at page 3246, and deposited in the Land Registry Office at Nelson as No. 657, exempting portion of Hampden Road (now Hampden Road and Hampden Street East), in the City of Nelson, from the provisions of section one hundred and seventeen of the Public Works Act, 1908, subject to a condition as to the building-line, by cancelling the condition as to the building-line imposed by the said Order in Council in so far as it affects the land fronting the portions of the said street shown coloured red on the plan marked P.W.D. 112032, deposited in the office of the Minister of Public Works at Wellington.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in him by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, and the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby authorize the Masterton Borough Council to permit the laying-off of the proposed street described in the Schedule hereto of a width less than sixty-six feet but not less than fifty feet, subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on that portion of the land fronting the southern side of the said street shown as Lots 5, 6, 7, and 8, on L.T. plan 12282, within a distance of forty-eight feet from the centre-line of such street.
