1. THESE regulations may be cited as the Government Life Insurance (Investment) Emergency Regulations 1941. 2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in section twenty-eight of the Government Life Insurance Act, 1908, it shall be lawful, with the approval of the Board constituted under that Act, to invest any part of the moneys from time to time in the Government Insurance Account in securities charged upon the public revenues of New Zealand issued in respect of any loan raised or to be raised for war purposes under the authority of the War Expenses Act, 1939, or of any Act that may be hereafter passed, or in securities issued in renewal or redemption or conversion of any such securities.
