The rate-book is kept at the office of the Collector of Rates aforesaid, where it is available for inspection at all times at which that office is open for the transaction of public business.

Class A.—On the unimproved value of all land classified as Class A by the person appointed to classify lands under section 3 of the Swamp Drainage Amendment Act, 1928, ninepence and ninety-four one-hundredths of a penny (9.94d.) in the pound.

Class B.—On the unimproved value of all land so classified as Class B, one penny and sixty-six one-hundredths of a penny (1.66d.) in the pound.

Authorizing the Laying-off of Roads of less Width than 66 ft.

WHEREAS in the opinion of the Minister of Lands it is inexpedient, by reason of the fact that the land shown upon the plan of Town of Kawaka Extension No. 10, affecting Kawaka No. 5M No. 2 Block, situated in Block XIII, Rotoiti Survey District, Auckland Land District, is intended to be used wholly for residential purposes, that Pah Road shown thereon should be of the width of 66 ft.:

Now, therefore, the Minister of Lands doth hereby, in pursuance of the power conferred upon him by section 17, subsection (1) of the Land Act, 1924, and of every other power him thereunto enabling, authorize the laying-off of Pah Road of a width of not less than 50 ft.: Provided always that it shall not be lawful for any person to erect or cause to be erected any building at a less distance than 33 ft. from the middle of such road.
