A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the twenty-eighth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, and published in the Gazette of the thirtieth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, at page 3174 (hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation"), areas of land totalling 18,404 acres, situated in the Rotorua County, Auckland Land District, were set apart as a permanent State forest in terms of section eighteen of the Forests Act, 1921-22, and whereas errors of description were made in the Schedule to the said Proclamation and it is

desirable that those errors be rectified:
