A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby set apart for the Greymouth-Hokitika Railway; and I do also hereby declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the sixth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one.

SCHEDULE.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of Crown land set apart: 35.8 perches.

Being closed road adjoining Railway Reserve and Section 3028.

Situated in Blocks XII and XVI, Greymouth Survey District (Westland R.D.). (S.O. 4256.)
