

4. GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF WORKS.

The licensee is hereby authorized, subject to the conditions hereof, to construct, maintain, and use the following works for the purposes of this license, the positions of the said works being indicated on the said plan P.W.D. 111649:—

- (a) Headworks consisting of a dam and intake and water-race leading to the water-wheel and power-house hereinafter referred to, giving a static head of approximately 12 ft.
- (b) A power-house with all necessary equipment for generating electricity.
- (c) Electric lines leading from the power-house aforesaid across parts 2c No. 1 and 1d No. 1 Kiwitahi Block, Cambridge Survey District, to the licensee's homestead situated on the said part 1d No. 1 Kiwitahi Block.

5. DURATION OF LICENSE.

Unless sooner determined, this license shall continue in force until the 31st day of March, 1962.

6. SYSTEM OF SUPPLY.

The system of supply shall be as described in paragraph (d) of clause 21-01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935. The generating and transmission voltages shall be approximately 230 volts direct current.

7. RENTAL.

For the purpose of assessing the annual rental payable in respect of this license, the licensee may install a suitable maximum-demand indicator to the satisfaction of the Inspecting Engineer of the Public Works Department, and failing such installation the rental shall be assessed on the maximum generating capacity of the plant installed. The present plant is rated at 7.5 kilowatts, and falls within the classes described in paragraph (c) of subclause (B) of clause (2) of Regulation 6 of the Water-power Regulations 1934.
