*Declaring Crown Lands in the Otago Land District to be subject  
to the Land for Settlements Act, 1925.*

WHEREAS the lands described in the Schedule  
hereto (hereinafter referred to as the "said  
lands") are Crown lands not acquired under the Land  
for Settlements Act, 1925, but are adjacent to certain  
lands acquired under the said Act, and known as the Dalmain  
Settlement and can conveniently be disposed of therewith :
