Exempting Crown Land from the Provisions of the Mining Act, 1926.

WHEREAS by section twenty of the Mining Act, 1926, W HEREAS by section twenty of the Mining Act, 1926, it is, *inter alia*, enacted that the Governor-General may from time to time, by notice in the *Gazette*, exempt any Crown lands from mining, or from any specified mining purpose, or from that Act, or any specified provisions of that Act, and that the lands to which any such notice relates shall be specified therein by words or particular description : And whereas it is desirable that the Crown land specified in the Schedule hereto should be exempted from the provisions of the Mining Act, 1926, and its amendments, subject to existing registered mining privileges.

existing registered mining privileges. Now, therefore, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on me by section twenty of the Mining Act, 1926, and of all other powers and authorities in anywise enabling me in that behalf, do hereby exempt the land particularly described in the Schedule hereto from the provisions of the Mining Act, 1926, subject to existing registered mining privileges; and do also hereby declare that such exemption shall take effect from the date of the militarian of the activity in the Carrier form the date of the publication of this notice in the Gazette.

Vesting the Control of a Scenic Reserve in the Waitemata County Council
