Allocating Railway Land to the Purposes of a Street in the Borough of Raetihi.

A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land which is described in the Schedule hereto (and which was taken for the Raetihi Branch of the North Island Main Trunk Railway, and is not now required for such purpose) shall, upon the publication hereof in the *New Zealand Gazette*, become street, and that such street shall be maintained by the Raetihi Borough Council in like manner as other streets are controlled and maintained by the said Council.

SCHEDULE.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land dealt with: 1 rood 38.72 perches.
Being Railway land.

Situated in Block VII, Makotuku Survey District. (S.O. 20512.)
