## SCHEDULE.

## NAPIER BREAD DELIVERY SCHEME 1941.

1. FOR the purposes of the scheme—

"The commodity" means bread:

"The district" means the Borough of Napier, the Town District of Taradale, and portion of the Hawke's Bay County as bounded by a red line on the plan:

"The plan" means the plan of the district deposited for the purposes of the scheme in the Head Office of the Transport Department at Wellington under No. 3292.

2. The scheme shall come into operation on the day following the date of the publication in the *Gazette* of notice of the approval of the scheme by the Minister of Supply.

3. The party to the scheme is the Napier District Bakeries, Ltd., of Napier, which is therefore entitled to deliver the commodity in the district.
