The Transport Legislation Suspension Order 1941 (No. 2).

PURSUANT to the Transport Legislation Emergency Regulations 1940* the Minister of Transport doth hereby order and declare as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Transport Legislation Suspension Order 1941 (No. 2).
- 2. The provisions of the Table of Axle-load Limits contained in Regulation 4 of the Heavy Motor-vehicle Regulations 1940† are hereby suspended for the period comprising the months of January and February, 1942, and in lieu thereof the following Table of Axle-load Limits is hereby substituted for the duration of the said period and no longer:—
