IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Dunedin City Council on the twenty-fourth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, viz. :—

“That the Dunedin City Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the City of Dunedin, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the north-eastern side of the portion of Wardlaw Street adjoining Lot 3, D.P. 5379, being part Section 72, Block VII, Town District, such land being comprised and described in Certificate of Title, Register-book Volume 300, folio 39” ; subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the north-eastern side of the portion of Wardlaw Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.

SCHEDULE.

THE north-eastern side of all that portion of street situated in the Otago Land District, City of Dunedin, known as Wardlaw Street, fronting Lot 3, D.P. 5379, being part Section 72, Block VII, Town District. “The Waimea County Council, being the local authority having control of the roads in the County of Waimea, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the northern portion of public road fronting the southern boundary, the eastern portion of public road fronting the western boundary, and the southern portion of public road fronting the northern boundary of subdivision of Section 103, and part Section 102, Square 5, Block IV, Tadmor Survey District, and contained in Certificate of Title, Volume 72, folio 106” ;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the northern, eastern, and southern sides of the portions of unnamed roads (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-five feet from the centre-lines of the said portions of roads.

SCHEDULE.

THE northern side of all that portion of an unnamed road situated in the Nelson Land District, County of Waimea, fronting Section 103 and part Section 102, Square 5, Block IV, Tadmor Survey District ; also the eastern side of all that portion of an unnamed road situated in the said land district and county fronting Section 103, Square 5, Block IV, Tadmor Survey District ; also the southern portion of an unnamed road situated in the said land district and county, fronting Section 103, and part Section 102, Square 5, Block IV, Tadmor Survey District.
