A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land which is described in the Schedule hereto (and which was acquired for the East Coast Main Trunk Railway and is not now required for such purpose) shall, upon the publication hereof in the *New Zealand Gazette*, become street, and that such street shall be maintained by the Wairoa Borough Council in like manner as other public highways are controlled and maintained by the said Council.

SCHEDULE.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land dealt with: 3 roods 3-1 perches.
Being part Railway land (Proclamation 1758), formerly part Section 20, Orangitirohia Block (Borough of Wairoa) (Hawke's Bay R.D.). (S.O. 1231, green.)
