ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 23rd day of December, 1942.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Lower Hutt City Council on the thirteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, viz.:—

“The Lower Hutt City Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the City of Lower Hutt, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the east side of Tama Street adjoining part Lot 132 and Lots 134, 136, 138, 140, 157, 156, and part Lot 154, and the west side of Mudie Street adjoining Lots 132, 134, 136, 138, 140, 150, 157, 156, 153, 158, D.P. 50, part Section 17, Hutt Registration District, Block XIII, Belmont Survey District”; subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the eastern side of portions of Tama Street and the western side of the portions of Mudie Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-lines of the said portions of streets.

SCHEDULE.

THE eastern side of the portions of street situated in the Wellington Land District, City of Lower Hutt, known as Tama Street, fronting part Lot 132 and Lots 134, 136, 138, 140, 157, 156, and part Lot 154 on D.P. 50, being part Section 17, Hutt Registration District, Block XIII, Belmont Survey District.

Also the western side of the portions of street situated in the said land district and city known as Mudie Street, fronting part Lot 132 and Lots 134, 136, 138, 140, 150, 157, 156, 153, 158 on D.P. 50, being part Section 17, Hutt Registration District, Block XIII, Belmont Survey District.
