Additional Land at Greymouth taken for the Purposes of the Greymouth-Hokitika Railway.

[L.S.] C. L. N. NEWALL, Governor-General. A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS it has been found desirable for the use, convenience, and enjoyment of the Greymouth-Hokitika

Railway to take further land at Greymouth in addition to land previously acquired for the purpose of the said railway : Now, therefore, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on me by sections thirty-four and two hundred and sixteen of the Public Works Act, 1928 and of every other power and authority in anywise 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes above mentioned.
