Provided that this Order shall not apply within the Dominion of New Zealand nor within any other territory for the defence of which His Majesty's Government in New Zealand is responsible unless and until the Air Forces of His Majesty raised in the Commonwealth of Australia are serving within the said Dominion or within any such territory.

Declaring Crown Land in the Hawke's Bay Land District to be subject to the Land for Settlements Act, 1925.

Now, therefore, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section one hundred and five of the said Act, and on the recommendation of the Land Settlement Board, and after considering the report of the Hawke's Bay District Land Board, do hereby declare the said land to be subject to the said Act; to the intent that it shall hereupon be deemed to be portion of the said Raumatī Settlement and may be disposed of accordingly.
