Excluding Land from the Kaipara Development Scheme.

PURSUANT to subsection (2) of section 4 of the Native Land Amendment Act, 1936, the Board of Native Affairs hereby revokes, so far as it affects the land described in the Schedule hereto, a certain notice dated the 26th day of November, 1937, and published in *Gazette* No. 78 of the 2nd day of December, 1937, at page 2636, whereby the said land (*inter alia*) was declared to be subject to Part I of the Native Land Amendment Act, 1936, and such land is hereby excluded from the Kaipara Development Scheme.
