"The maximum charge for electrical energy shall not exceed Is. 3d. per unit for lighting purposes and 9d. per unit for motor-power, heating, or cooking purposes : Provided that "lighting purposes" shall include the operation of motor-generators for lighting purposes; and provided further that from and after the 1st day of April, 1944, the maximum charge for electrical energy shall not exceed 1s. per unit for lighting purposes and 6d. per unit for motor-power, heating, or cooking purposes."

WHEREAS the several local authorities enumerated in the Schedule hereto, being desirous of raising the respective loans W stated opposite their names therein, have respectively complied with the provisions of the Local Government Loans Board Act, 1926 (hereinafter called "the said Act"), and it is expedient that the precedent consent of the Governor-General

(1) The terms for which the said loans or any parts thereof may be raised shall be the respective terms (in years) stated

 (1) The terms for which the said loans of any parts thereof may be failed shall be the respective terms (in years) stated in the fourth column of the said Schedule.
 (2) The rates of interest that may be paid in respect of the said loans or any parts thereof shall be such as shall not produce to the lender or lenders a rate or rates exceeding the respective rates per centum per annum stated in the fifth column of the said Schedule.

(3) The said respective loans or any parts thereof, together with interest thereon, shall be repaid by equal aggregate annual or half-yearly instalments extending over the respective terms as determined in (1) above.
(4) The payment of such instalments shall be made in New Zealand, and no such instalment shall be paid out of loan-

monevs (5) The rate payable for brokerage, underwriting, and procuration fees in respect of the raising of the said respective loans or any parts thereof shall not in the aggregate exceed one-half per centum of any amount raised.
(6) No moneys shall be borrowed under this consent after the expiration of two years from the date hereof.
