A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Proclamation dated the twenty-seventh day of February, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 23 of the fifth day of the following month at page 620, setting apart Crown land for the development of water power (cottage-site) in Block II, Town of Edendale.
