## AUCKLAND ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD.

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Auckland Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and principal on a loan of £164,000, authorized to be raised by the Auckland Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of repaying, to the extent that sinking funds are insufficient, the Electric-power Extension Loan, 1921, of £500,000, the Auckland Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-fifteenth of a penny ( $\frac{1}{15}$ d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value on the basis of capital value of all rateable property in the Auckland Electric-power District, comprising the City of Auckland, together with the Boroughs of Onehunga, Otahuhu, Manurewa, Mount Albert, Mount Eden, One Tree Hill, Newmarket, and Papakura, the Road Districts of Mount Roskill, Panmure, and Mount Wellington, the Town Districts of Ellerslie, Papatoetoe, and Howick, and the County of Manukau; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten years or until the loan is fully paid off."
