Dunedin Milk Delivery Scheme, 1942, amended.

WHEREAS by a notice (hereinafter referred to as "the said notice") published in the *Gazette* on the 5th day of March, 1942, at page 634, the Minister of Supply and Munitions, pursuant to Regulation 3 of the Delivery Emergency Regulations 1940, approved the Dunedin Milk Delivery Scheme, 1942 (hereinafter referred to as "the scheme");

And whereas it is desired to amend the scheme by a readjustment of the authority for certain of the deliveries of milk authorized by the scheme:

Now, therefore, the Minister of Supply and Munitions, pursuant to the said Regulation 3, doth hereby amend the table (contained in clause 3 of the Schedule to the said notice), describing the persons entitled to deliver the commodity in the district and the extent to which they are so entitled, by revoking therein (for zone numbered 58) the words "Mr. Mooney, 164 North Road, Dunedin," and substituting therefor the words "Mr. A. Brown, Norwood Street, Dunedin."
