

## Price Order No. 97 (Solders and Wiping Metals).

PURSUANT to the powers conferred on it by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939\*, the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, doth hereby make the following Price Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 97.

2. The maximum price at which solders and wiping metals of the grades specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto may be sold anywhere in New Zealand shall be not more than the respective price set out in the said Schedule opposite each such grade of solder and wiping metal according to the quantity sold and according to whether the sale is to a reseller or to a consumer.

3. The maximum prices in the said Schedule include sales tax.
