WHEREAS the Wellington City Council (hereinafter called "the said local authority"), being desirous of raising the sum of two hundred and ninety-four thousand pounds (£294,000), by a loan to be known as "Wellington City Antecedent Liability Loan, 1923, Renewal Loan, 1943" (hereinafter called "the said loan"), for the purpose of repaying, to the extent that sinking funds are not available, a loan of £340,000 raised in London in 1923, has complied with the provisions of the Local Government Loans Board Act, 1926 (hereinafter called "the said Act"), and it is expedient that the precedent consent of the Governor-General in Council, as required by the said Act, should be given to the raising of the said loan:

(3) The said loan or any part thereof, together with interest thereon, shall be repaid by equal aggregate annual or half-yearly instalments extending over the term as determined in (1) above.
