IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Hutt County Council on the fifteenth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, viz. :—

“The Hutt County Council, being the local authority having control of the roads in the County of Hutt, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to that portion of road abutting on to Moore's Valley Road, situated in Section 2, C.T. 352/178, Wainui-o-mata Registration District”;

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Auckland City Council on the fifth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two (in so far as it affects the side and portion of street described in the Schedule hereto), viz. :—

“That the Auckland City Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the City of Auckland, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to that portion of St. George's Bay Road adjoining part Allotment 81, Section 1, Suburbs of Auckland, and being all the land comprised in C.T. 554/16”;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the eastern side of the portion of St. George's Bay Road (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.
