Otahuhu and Area Milk Delivery Scheme, 1942, amended.

WHEREAS by a notice (hereinafter referred to as "the said HEREAS by a notice (hereinatter referred to as the said notice) published in the Gazette on the 12th day of February, 1942, at page 504, the Minister of Supply and Munitions, pursuant to Regulation 3 of the Delivery Emergency Regulations 1940, approved the Otahuhu and Area Milk Delivery Scheme, 1942 (hereinafter referred to as "the scheme"):

And whereas the said regulations have been revoked by the Delivery Emergency Regulations.

Delivery Emergency Regulations 1942:

And whereas it is desired to amend the scheme for the purposes described hereunder:

Now, therefore, the Minister of Transport, pursuant to the Delivery Emergency Regulations 1942, doth hereby amend the scheme by adding thereto the following clauses:-

- "5. (1) For the purpose of assisting in the administration of this scheme there shall be a committee to be named the 'Otahuhu and Area Milk Zoning Committee,' which shall consist of the following members:
 - "(a) Two members to be appointed by the Otahuhu Borough
 - Council:

 "(b) One member to be appointed jointly by the Manukau
 County Council and the Mount Wellington Road Board:
 - "(c) Two members to be appointed by the vendors who are parties to the scheme:

 "(d) The Zoning Officer for the North Island.

"(2) Any member of the committee may at any time resign

his office by writing addressed to the Minister.

"(3) On the death or resignation of any member of the committee, the vacancy created thereby shall be filled by appointment in the manner in which the vacating member was appointed.

"(4) The functions of the committee shall be to receive and

(4) The functions of the committee shall be to receive and investigate complaints affecting the administration of this scheme, to advise the Minister on any matter that may be referred to the committee by the Minister or that may be considered by it of its own motion, and to make recommendations to the Minister for amending this scheme.

"(5) Subject to the foregoing provisions of this scheme the committee may regulate its procedure in such manner as it thinks fit."
