**P**URSUANT to the Harbours Act, 1923, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby license and permit the Vincent County Council (hereinafter called "the Council," which term shall include its successors or assigns unless the context requires a different construction), to use and occupy parts of the foreshore and land below low-water mark at Hunter Valley and Meade's in Lake Hawea as sites for wharves, as shown on approved plans marked M.D. 8158, 8160; 8159 and 8160 respectively, and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington, subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

1. THIS license is subject to the Foreshore License Regulations 1940, and the provisions of those regulations shall, so far as applicable, apply hereto.
2. The term of the license shall be fourteen years from the date hereof.
3. The annual sum payable by the Council shall be 1s. payable on demand.
4. The master of every vessel discharging ballast at the said wharves shall have all such ballast taken away and deposited above high-water mark, or at such place as may be approved by the Minister or by any person appointed by the Minister for that purpose.
