### SCHEDULE.

## THE WELLINGTON DRY CLEANING DELIVERY SCHEME, 1942.

(1) For the purposes of this scheme, unless the context otherwise requires,-

- "The district" means the cities of Wellington and Lower Hutt and the boroughs of Petone, Upper Hutt, and Eastbourne:
  "Dry-cleaning" means the cleaning of apparel principally by the use of solvent:
  "The plan " means the plan of the district deposited for the purposes of the scheme in the Head Office of the Transport Department at Wellington under No. TT. 3352:
  "Minister" means the Minister of Transport:
  "Zone" means a zone of the district marked on the said plan.
