## SCHEDULE.

## THE CHRISTCHURCH ICE-CREAM DELIVERY SCHEME 1942.

(1) FOR the purposes of this scheme, unless the context otherwise requires,—

- “The district” means the City of Christchurch and environs as indicated by zones marked on the plan;
- “The plan” means the plan of the district deposited for the purposes of the scheme in the Head Office of the Transport Department at Wellington under No. TT. 3356;
- “Minister” means the Minister of Transport;
- “Zone” means a zone of the district marked on the said plan.

(2) For the purposes of assisting in the administration of this scheme there shall be a committee which shall consist of the members constituting from time to time the Executive Committee under Regulation 3 of the Christchurch Milk Delivery Emergency Regulations 1942, together with an additional member appointed by the parties to the scheme.

(3) The functions of the committee shall be to receive and investigate complaints affecting the administration of this scheme, to advise the Minister on any matters that may be referred to the committee by the Minister or that may be considered by it of its own motion, and to make recommendations to the Minister for amending this scheme.

(4) Subject to the foregoing provisions of this scheme, the committee may regulate its procedure in such manner as it thinks fit.
