RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE.

*The Central Hawke's Bay Electric-power Board Supplementary Reticulation Loan, £5,000.*

**I**N pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Central Hawke's Bay Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, principal, and other charges on a loan of five thousand (£5,000), authorized to be raised by the Central Hawke's Bay Electric-power

Board pursuant to the provisions of section 15 of the Finance Act (No. 2), 1936, for the purpose of further reticulation of the Board's area, the said Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-sixtieth of a penny ( $\frac{1}{60}$ d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Central Hawke's Bay Electric-power Board District, and such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st of November in each and every year during the currency of such loan, and being a period of twenty (20) years or until the loan is fully paid off."
