

Block X, and Section 7, Block XIII, Clifford Bay Survey District, skirting the course of the Blind River in a south-westerly direction, and Section 8, Block XIII, Clifford Bay Survey District, and the southern boundaries of Section 13, 12, and part 9, Block XXII, and Sections 5, 4, 3, Block XXI, Taylor Pass Survey District, to the point of commencement; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of November in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years or until the loan is fully paid off."
