- .(2) For the purpose of assisting in the administration of this scheme, there shall be a committee which shall consist of the following members:-
 - (a) The two members appointed for the time being for the purpose of paragraph (a) of clause (2) of the Milk Scheme:
 - (b) One member to be appointed by the parties to this scheme:(c) The Zoning Officer for the North Island.

(c) The Zoning Officer for the North Island.

(3) On the death or resignation of any member of the committee, the vacancy created thereby shall be filled by appointment in the manner in which the vacating member was appointed.

(4) The functions of the committee shall be to receive and investigate complaints affecting the administration of the scheme, to advise the Minister on any matters that may be referred to the committee by the Minister or that may be considered by it of its own motion, and to make recommendations to the Minister for amending this scheme.

(5) Subject to the foregoing provisions of this scheme the committee may regulate its procedure in such manner as it thinks fit.

fit.

(6) It shall be a condition of this scheme that meat may be delivered in the district by any vendor to any person, whether or not that person is a wholesale purchaser for the purposes of the scheme, on such three days in any week during the months of December, January, and February in each year, and on such two days in any week during the months of March to November (inclusive) in each year, as the Minister or a Zoning Officer shall from time to time appoint in respect of the scheme, but that otherwise meat may be delivered in the district to the premises of wholesale purchasers only.
