A PROCLAMATION

In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto (and which was taken for a further portion of the line of railway from Palmerston North by way of Manawatu Gorge to Woodville, Palmerston Gorge Section, and is not now required for such purpose) shall, upon the publication hereof in the New Zealand Gazette, become road, and that such road shall be maintained by the Oroua County Council in like manner as other public highways are controlled and maintained by the said Council.
