THE ASHBURTON ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, The Ashburton Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of forty-eight thousand two hundred and fifty pounds (£48,250), authorized to be raised by The Ashburton Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of redeeming the outstanding liability in respect of sections 2 of £30,000 and 5 of £25,000 of the Special Loan, 1922, £326,150, which mature respectively on 14th May, 1943, and 21st October, 1943, the said The Ashburton Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-thirteenth (1/13th) of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Ashburton Electric-power District, comprising the area as proclaimed by proclamation dated the 14th day of November, 1921, and extended by proclamation dated the 14th day of March, 1933; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable half-yearly on the 14th day of May and the 14th day of November in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years (20) or until the loan is fully paid off."
