In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim as stopped the Government road described in the Schodyle heavest guely road being no longer required. Schedule hereto, such road being no longer required.

Revoking Portion of a Proclamation taking Land for Public Works

In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Proclamation dated the fifteenth day of Tune one thousand pine hundred and fauth three and published of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-three, and published in the New Zealand Gazette No. 46 of the seventeenth day of the same month at page 676, taking land for public works, in so far as it affects the area of land tenthly described in the Schedule thereto.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and section thirty-two of the Statutes Amendment Act, 1936, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for housing purposes; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the twelfth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and forty-three.
