IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in him by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby order and declare that the portion of road described in the Schedule hereto shall, on and after the date of this Order in Council, become Government road.

WHEREAS by Order in Council dated the seventh day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven, and published in the *Gazette* of the fifteenth day of the same month at page 1637, the Kaipara Steamship Company, of Helensville, was licensed to occupy a part of the foreshore and land below low-water mark at Dargaville, Kaihu Creek, Northern Wairoa River, as a site for a wharf:

And whereas it is desirable to revoke the said Order in Council of the seventh day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven:

BY virtue of the powers and authorities vested in me by the thirty-fourth section of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, do hereby order and declare that the reserve for recreation in the Otago Land District, described in the Schedule hereto, shall be and the same is hereby brought under the operation of and declared to be subject to the provisions of Part II of the said Act, and such reserve shall hereafter form part of the Alexandra Domain, and be managed, administered, and dealt with as a public domain by the Alexandra Domain Board.
