# A PROCLAMATION

A PROCLAMATION

In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for harbour works and shall vest in the Whangarei Harbour Board as from the date hereinafter mentioned; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the twenty-seventh day of September, one thousand nine hundred and forty-three.

## SCHEDULE

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land taken: 2 acres 3 roods 35 perches.

Being part Okara Block.

Situated in Block IX, Whangarei Survey District (Auckland R.D.). (S.O. 32873.)

In the North Auckland Land District; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 117766, deposited in the office of the Minister of Works at Wellington, and thereon edged yellow.
