Price Order No. 184 (Amending Price Order No. 177 (Tomatoes))

PURSUANT to the powers conferred on it by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,* the Price Tribunal, acting with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Com-merce, doth hereby make the following amending, Price Order :--

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 184, and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 177† (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

2. This Order shall come into force on the 15th day of January, 1944.

3. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by inserting after the words "Auckland Provincial District" the words " (exclusive of the Cook County and that portion of the Wairoa County that is within the Auckland Provincial District)", and by inserting after the words "Hawke's Bay Provincial District" the words " (including the whole of the Wairoa County) and the Cook County."
