RICHMOND BOROUGH COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Richmond Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of nine thousand pounds (£9,000), authorized to be raised by the Richmond Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of constructing a pipe-line from Poorman's Valley Road, Stoke, to connect the present borough water-supply system with the Roding River waterworks constructed by the Nelson City Council under the Nelson Waterworks Extension Act, 1935, the said Richmond Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of seven-sixteenths of a penny (7/16d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of capital value) of all rateable property in the Borough of Richmond; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty years or until the loan is fully paid off."
