IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon him by section seventeen of the Public Reserves, Domains, and National Parks Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby extend the period for which the control of the reserve described in the Schedule hereto (being a reserve for a site for a memorial hall) was vested in the Hawarden Memorial Hall Board, as constituted by an Order in Council dated the twenty-fourth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, and published in the *Gazette* of the third day of May, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, for five years from the twenty-fourth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and forty-three, to the twenty-third day of April, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, and doth hereby declare that the provisions of the said Order in Council shall continue in force for the said extended period.
